## Sorus of Adiantum (Slide - Spot)




Fig. 23: Adiantum — Sorus Showing Sporangia and False Indusium

- 1. On the underside of apical lobes of pinnae of *Adiantum* mature leaves (sporophylls) reddish brown bodies are borne, called **sori**.
- 2. Each sorus is a group of sporangia.
- 3. The sori are covered by a false indusium which is for protection of sporangia.
- 4. Each sporangium consists of a capsule and a lower stalk.
- 5. The capsule has a single layer of cells which consists of two portions. Thin walled portion is the **stomium** and thick cutinized region is called **annulus**.
- 6. By means of stomium capsule ruptures and spores are liberated out.
- 7. In sporangium spore-mother cells are present, which produce spores by reduction division.
